Research and Publication Award 2023 was held at Uttara University on Saturday at the Multipurpose Hall of the university's permanent campus.

From a list of over 300 publications, the ceremony awarded the top 50 researchers with the highest impact factor from its academic community.

Organized by the Centre for Research and Training (CRT), UU's contribution to research and indexed publication saw a 300% increment in research output in

international journals and considerable improvement in its Web of Science and SCOPUS citation index, compared to last year's award ceremony.

The researchers received recognition through certification and awards.
